



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Ensure that power has been turned off by switching the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse from the fuse panel.
- 2. If replacing a previous fixture, remove that fixture and ensure recessed depth is of the appropriate height, at least 4.75".
- 3. Preview and select the desired color temperature using CCT switch, see figure 1.
- 4. Screw E26 adapter into the housing socket, see figure 2.
- 5. Connect the orange connector to the E26 bulb as shown in figure 3.
- 6. Squeeze torsion spring arms and install into the spring brackets within the housing, as seen in figure 4.
- 8. With the torsion springs in position, tuck all remaining wire into housing and push the fixture into the housing until flush with ceiling, see figure 5.
- 9. Installation is now complete. Restore power and the light is not operational.










